#### UP Book Review (Victor)

There have been reviews per month by Tyler, Victor, Debbie and Donna Winters A variety of genres Librarians are taking notice of this as well

### UP Reader Report (Victor)

About 200 copies of UP Reader #5 sold including audiobooks, ebooks Some have been purchased in multiples for resale Action Step: Brandy plans to complete the recording of all editions by mid-June for submission to Audible

### Webmaster Report (Jenifer)

Members submitted two published works last month

# **Report (Larry)**

Total Resources: 5,500 Expenses have been about \$200 per month this year This will be reduced after June \$75 compensation to virtual conference speakers will end in June \$100 Notable Books speaker compensation will drop to \$75 (September 2021) Income will likely drop for the year as most memberships are in There was a discussion of standard UPPAA conference speaker cost: Per Tyler:

\$75 for regular speakers

\$100 plus travel for keynote

Victor said the royalty payout from UP Reader sales will be about \$400 - \$500 on August 1st 2021

Next Steps / Items Held Over: In future meeting, discuss Larry's suggestion that we may need to spend more to attract people to return to the conference

### **Dandelion Cottage**

Larry is waiting for hard cover books to arrive to distribute at the same time as award money and medals

Victor is donating 40 hardcovers to SuperiorLand Library Co-Op for their 45 member libraries People want photos with medallion

Action Steps: Larry will distribute books and medals

Debbie will help with distribution of medals and photos of recipients

Next Steps / Items Held Over: Consider including in-person author events in the Summer Newsletter

### Membership: (Brandy Thomas)

Three new members joined in the past month

Memberships are down to 79 from 101 before renewals
